Clinic Requirements

Participants **MUST** meet the following Requirements to participate in the CHA Standard Instructor Certification Clinic.

- Be 16 years or older to receive Assistant Instructor Certification.
- Be 18 years or older to receive the Instructor certification at any level.
- Experience in horsemanship with good control at the walk, trot and lope or canter.
- Can catch, lead, saddle and handle horses without assistance.
- Prior teaching experience is helpful, but not required.

Certification will depend on meeting CHA standards, especially in safety and ability to work effectively with people and horses at the level desired. Both English and Western will be offered for certification.

Ending : Friday, May 18th, 2018



Important Information

Clinic cost **\$800.00** per person for full clinic participants, **\$250.00** for auditors.

- You **MUST BE** present for all of the clinic to receive certification.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$250.00 is due at time of registration to hold your spot. We are limited to 10 participants, so get your deposit in soon.
- Full balance is due 10 days before start of clinic. Make checks payable to: Teresa Wentland
- Materials and manuals will be sent after deposit is received.
- Breakfast and lunch are included for all paid participants and auditors.
- Clinic will run from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. each day.
